- c. 3RD OFFENSE: The driver will give a written report to a school administrator. The school administrator will contact the student and inform the student of the alleged misconduct. The student will be given the opportunity to orally respond. The school administrator will contact parents/guardians for a conference. The student may be suspended from the bus pending this conference. The suspension may be extended five days beyond the conference date at the discretion of the school administrator and Transportation staff.
- d. **4TH OFFENSE:** The driver will give a written report to a school administrator. The school administrator will contact the student and inform the student of the alleged misconduct. The student will be given the opportunity to orally respond. The school administrator will contact the parents/guardians for a conference. The student may be suspended from the bus for the semester at the discretion of the school administrator and Transportation staff.
- e. **SERIOUS RULE VIOLATIONS:** The driver will complete and submit to the school administration a bus conduct report or incident report involving the occurrence of any student behavior involving weapons or the making of terroristic threats, any student behavior which affects safety, and any serious rule violations. A student may be suspended from the bus at any time without the existence of prior rule violations if the school administrator and/ or Transportation staff determines it is warranted because of the seriousness of the rule violation. Other disciplinary consequences in addition to suspension of bus privileges may occur as described in the *Responsibilities of Students* in the Lincoln Public Schools *Important Information Booklet*.

Parents/guardians may appeal a decision to suspend bus privileges by contacting the director of student services in writing to request a review. The decision of the director of student services is final.
